CURRENT INTERVENTIONS / ACTIVITIES

1. Conversion of SHIP Micro Finance programme into ' Solve Laghubitta Bittiya Sanstha Ltd.' a 'D' class bank

SOLVE-Nepal since BS 2058 (2001) was running Micro Finance programme in the name of SHIP Micro Finance programme having with more than 24000 women beneficiaries in the five different districts of Province No. 1. In the process of conversion it is renamed ' Solve Laghubitta Bittiya Sanstha Ltd.' and service areas are 10 districts of Province No. 1 as permitted by Central Bank of Nepal under Bank and Financial Institution Act, 2073.

2. Women Social and Economic Empowerment for Social Justice and Peace

Under this organizational strategy, SOLVE is implementing Socio Economic Empowerment of Disadvantaged Women (SEED) project in the funding of FCA in the southern areas of Lalitpur district, Nepal. The main activities under this project are;

Formation and strengthening of women cooperative for their social and economic empowerment through generating small capital in local level and properly utilization in women income generating and micro enterprise development. SOLVE is constantly organizing capacity development and skill development programme to make them self sustainable with a strong local level organization to mitigate not only their economic need but also addressing other social issues like

accessing finance to the rural poor to uplift their socio-economic status using micro loans in specific income generating business and initiatives. SOLVE-Nepal will handover all it's women members of micro finance programme to the newly establish bank after it's completion of certification process. But, SOLVE will continue it's innovation and capacity development activities to these women through arranging different capacity building and social mobilization programme.

action against women violence, linking with local government and create lobby for the utilization of budget properly for the benefit of women beneficiaries. There are more than 4000 household representation in 11 women cooperative in Lalitpur district only. The project is running in 12 wards of 3 Rural Municipalities and 1 Municipality of Lalitpur.



3. Natural resource management and Climate Change Adaptation

Under this strategy, SOLVE is implementing many activities associated with the community development. SOLVE implemented Improved Cooking Stove collaborating with Alternative Energy Promotion Centre (AEP), Namsaling Community Development Committee (NCDC), and Centre for Rural Technology Nepal (CRT/N). Currently, there are two projects running in some of the wards of Rural Municipalities in Lalitpur district.

4. Rural Water Supply, Health and Sanitation

SOLVE Nepal since last 25 years is deeply involved in implementing Water Supply, Health and Sanitation programme in the different districts of Nepal. Since 1993 to 2000, the project implemented in Rasuwa district under JAKPAS (World Bank direct funding) and Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Fund Development Board (RWSSFDB) fund, from 2000 to 2016 in Makawanpur district then after 2017 to till date SOLVE is implementing water supply schemes, WASH and one house one

leadership of SOLVE-Nepal in Lalitpur district. The project covers 1 wards each from Konjyosom RM, Bagmati RM and Mahankal RM of Lalitpur targeting to generate income of those affected household from the earthquake of 2072 (April, 2015) in Nepal. The project is not only limited in making aware and preparation of plan to mitigate the challenges of Disaster Risks Reduction (DRR) but also introduce appropriate technology to increase the productivity of their land and livestock.

tab programme in Lalitpur district. In this context SOLVE is heavily involved to declare Open Defecation Free (ODF) areas in Lalitpur.

SOLVE has good experiences in adapting gravity flow system, lifting technology, rain water harvesting, cloud harvesting technology, resource protection and rehabilitation of earthquake damaged water supply schemes to access people in pure drinking water supply.



5. Local Governance and Accountability

SOLVE has good track record working Governance issues, which is deeply related with internal management of organization to collaborating with local government supporting and enabling their strengths, mobilizing resources and helping in planning process. In 1998 SOLVE formed a CMC (Change management Committee) to reform it's organizational rules, regulations and formulation of policies. With successfully implementation of our own policies, SOLVE began to support local governments, community schools in this sector for their capacity building.

Currently, SOLVE is implementing a SUSHASAN project under the cooperation of CECI. With the main objective of the project is to leverage and mainstream integrated technologies for promoting good governance and social accountability in Nepal. The project will enhance the capacity of

citizens, Women and Marginalized Groups (WMG) to participate in and influence decision making processes at local government levels, through integrated technologies. Established Techno Hubs (THs) at municipal/rural municipal and community levels, within existing facilities of government, civil society organizations and in community centers. The Techno Hubs will also be used by the CSOs, communities, WMG, to access relevant data/information to hold local government accountable, developing off line mechanisms linking with online technology. The project will work with local governments to build their capacity toward E-Governance. The project will facilitate the development/ adaptation of technological governance tools and provide technical ongoing support for better use of the tools and mechanisms for data collection, information sharing and accountability.
